**SIMPSON WATER OFFERING SCHOLARSHIP
TO SIMPSON COUNTY SENIORS**

Franklin, KY – To promote education in the region while reinforcing efforts to support development of a quality workforce, Simpson County Water District is launching a \$1,000 scholarship program. The scholarship, awarded annually, will go to Simpson County graduates planning to attend Western Kentucky University or Bowling Green Technical College (Franklin/Bowling Green campuses).

“The service we provide is closely linked to the quality of life in Simpson County and to the young people who are educated here,” said Alan Vilines, SCWD general manager. “We see this scholarship as one more way we can serve our community and our customers.”

The 2010 Simpson County graduating seniors will be the first group eligible for the SCWD scholarship. The scholarship is renewable for four years, as long as scholarship requirements are maintained.

The scholarship program will be administered by the College Heights Foundation at Western Kentucky University.

“We are excited about Simpson Water joining the other civic organizations, companies, and strong alumni base that already support scholarships for students. We look forward to contributing our assistance in their scholarship program,” said Alex Downing, President of the College Heights Foundation at WKU.
